

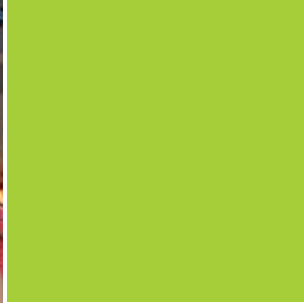

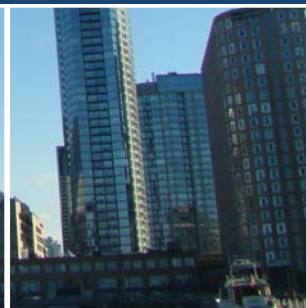
enrich the students' summer adventures.

GLENDON CAMPUS

The Glendon Campus of York University is located in one of the best residential neighbourhoods in Canada. The Hilliard Residence, where IH Toronto students reside, was opened in 1964. The residence offers well furnished single and double room accommodations.

Each student is provided with a bed, a dresser, shelving, a telephone, a desk and a chair. A security

pass provides access to the residence and students have keys to their rooms. Internet access is available at the computer labs located on campus.

Each wing of the residence has a television room, shared washroom and shower facilities. Laundry facilities are available on a pay-per-use card system in the Hilliard Residence.

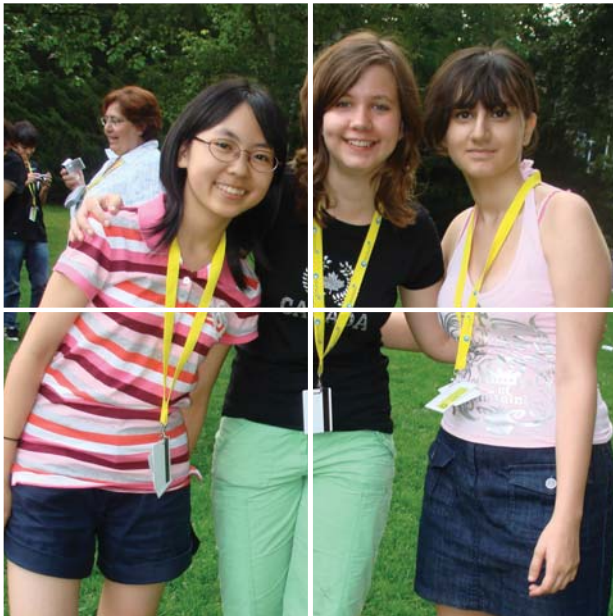

Teenage Adventure Program (TAP) Glendon Campus

To give all of our students the best possible experience, we offer our Teenage Programs in two age categories.

Students 12, 13, or 14 years old will join the Glendon Campus program. This program offers students 20 hours of English lessons per week, combined with afternoon and evening activities suitable for this age group.

Students will spend the morning studying English in multi-level, multi-cultural classes with certified ESL teachers.

Afternoons and evenings are spent with our energetic Activity Coordinators taking part in activities, outings and excursions that are designed to optimize the learning experience of this age group. In this age range some supervised free time is provided to give the students opportunities to interact with each other in a way they are most comfortable.

Like all of junior programs, this program is supervised 24 hours a day and provides an excellent learning opportunity, academically and socially, for all participants.

Teenage Adventure Program (TAP)

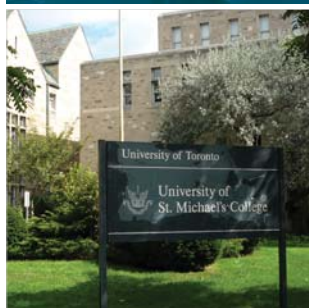
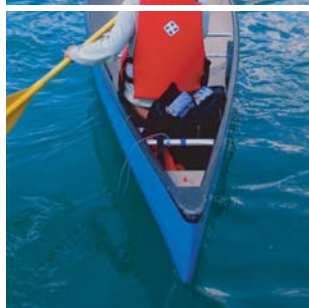
St. Michael's Campus

Students 15, 16 and 17 years old will join the St. Michael's Campus Program at the University of Toronto. This program offers students 20 hours of English lessons per week combined with afternoon and evening activities most suitable to the age group. The academic portion of this program includes a TOEFL Preparation program for higher level English learners.

Students will spend the morning studying English in multi-level, multicultural classes with certified ESL teachers.

Afternoons and evenings are spent with our energetic Activity Coordinators taking part in activities, outings and excursions that are designed to optimized the learning experience of this age group. Because of the maturity level of this age group, more free time is provided for the students in order to give them opportunities to interact with each other and explore the city in a supervised fashion.

Like all IH Junior Programs, this program is supervised 24 hours a day and provides an excellent learning opportunity, academically and socially for all participants.



St Michael's CAMPUS

The St. Michael's campus at the University of Toronto is located steps away from major attractions such as the Royal Ontario Museum (ROM), The Ontario Parliament and other attractions at the Bloor and Queen's Park intersection.

Each student is provided with a bed, a dresser, shelving, a telephone, a desk and a chair. A security pass provides access to the residence and rooms.

High-speed Internet access is available in the dormitory rooms. Rooms are available in both single and double occupancy style.

Each house in the residence has a television room, shared washrooms and shower facilities. Laundry facilities are available on a pay-per-use system in the residence building.

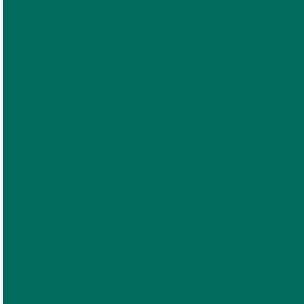
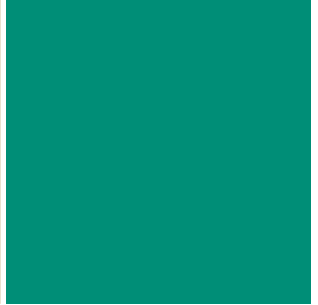
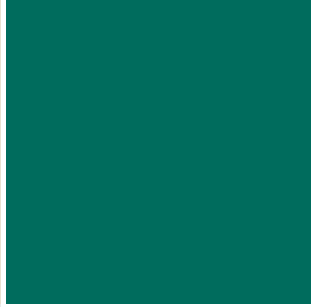
We don't only offer the most exclusive Junior Programs in Toronto, but we are also the best language school for adults in Canada.

ILLC Residential or Homestay Option

The ILLC residence option at University of Ryerson is a hotel-style accommodation located less than ten minutes walk from International House Toronto's adult campus.

Rooms at ILLC offer a queen size bed, dresser, desk and chair, bedside table, alarm clock, wardrobe unit, internet access (not included in price), telephone with voice mail, individual air control, en-suite washroom and shower and cable TV.

The residence also features a shared kitchenette for making snacks, vending machines, a common lounge with cable TV and pay-per-use laundry facilities.

The homestay accommodation offers a great value choice for parents who are looking to spend time with host families and practice English. Homestay locations vary depending on the needs and preferences of students and time of booking.

Each homestay offers a single furnished room with a Canadian host family. You will also have access to the family kitchen, washroom, shower and all common living spaces of the house. The homestay option offers a half-board meal plan (breakfast and dinner).

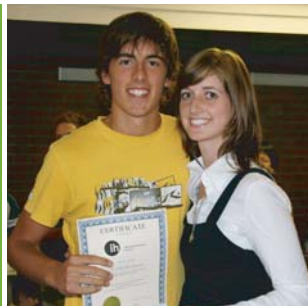
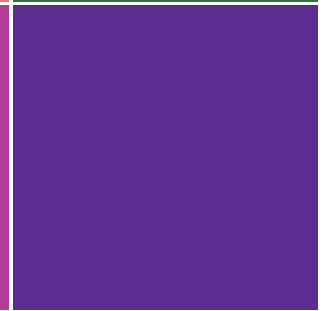
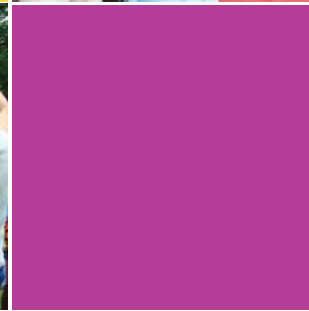
